One of the aspects of the Festival that we must retain is its unique character as a "Festival" rather than a carnival. In their book, *La Storia, Five Centuries of the Italian American Experience* by Jerre Mangione and Ben Morreale, they describe the distinctive mark of the Italian Festival as it was incorporated into the Italian enclaves of U.S. cities during the age of immigration. It was, first and foremost, a religious festa in honor of a patron saint. Although there was much singing, dancing, feasting, and drinking, the religious element of the Festival remained prominent, especially with the procession of the saint throughout the streets of the neighborhood – to the dismay of the non-Italian residents who could not quite understand the significance of the celebration and, in some quarters, found the whole thing an annoyance. As we join in the entertainment, the good food and drink, and the fellowship of each other's company, let us not forget the faith that undergirds our annual Festival. We encounter Jesus Christ in many ways. The celebration of the Festa is one way in which we affirm our faith in our heritage and in our faith. May the days ahead be for us a time of renewal and rededication to the essential mission of our parish – that we be ever more deeply rooted in our commitment to bear witness to the glorious favors that the Lord bestows on us and all who will visit us in the week of our Fête.

## 7th Annual Italian Festival Home Winemakers' Competition

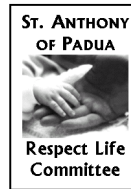
