Our young Altar Server corps is a very important component of our opportunity for youth ministry in the parish. The young and teenaged boys and girls of the community can be so helpful in our weekend and special liturgies throughout the course of the year. Acting as an Altar Server is a perfect way for our young parishioners to get involved in the life of the parish. I would like to extend an invitation to all our young people from the age of fourth grade to high school to enroll in Altar Server ministry. It is not necessary to be a student in the parish grade school to serve at the Altar of the Lord. All that is necessary is a willingness by the young person and her/his parents to be available to serve when scheduled for the Masses on the weekends, and for a funeral or wedding on the weekend. During the weekdays, funeral Altar Servers are appointed from the parish school roster of Servers — only because Servers from other schools are not free for help on school days. It is a wonderful experience to fulfill the role of an Altar Server — a lifelong memory that supports the faith of a person as he/she grows into the faith life of an adult.

If you are a student in our parish school and are interested in joining the Altar Server corps, please contact Mr. Shields. If you are a student in another school who has received First Communion and are in the fourth grade or beyond and would like to join the corps of Altar Servers, please call, or ask your parents to call, the rectory to make arrangements to sign into a very important work and ministry in our parish.

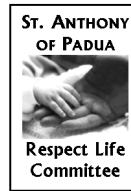
Thank a Priest on Priesthood Sunday
